Fire/Evacuation Drill Report

Fire/Evacuation drills are required once a month

Procedure:

- 1. Record information on this form. You will be asked to return this completed form once a month to your Alta Mira Service Coordinator.
- 2. Announce fire/evacuation drill to all occupants of home. Make sure to have the drill at different times of the day, including evenings and early mornings.
- 3. Be sure everyone knows they need to leave the house. Check the time.
- 4. Monitor everyone's exit. Make sure everyone gets out of the house.
- 5. Make sure all disabled individuals are assisted as needed.
- 6. Have everyone go at least 100 yards (8-10 car lengths) from the house and meetat a pre-determined safe place
- 7. Once everyone is at the safe place, check the time again. Figure how long it took everyone to get out of the house to the safe place.
- 8. After everyone is together, you may return to the house.
