

Electronic Visit Verification Update

As you may have heard, many of our waiver services began a new requirement called Electronic Visit Verification (EVV) on January 1, 2021. EVV is federally mandated as part of the 21st Century Cures Act and requires six data points to be collected when services are provided.

- 1. Type of service performed
- 2. Individual receiving services
- 3. Individual providing services
- 4. Date of the service
- 5. Location of the service
- 6. Time services begins and ends

There has been much information shared about this new requirement and we at Alta Mira would like to make sure that you understand how this may affect the services you provide or receive.

These are currently the only New Mexico waiver services that are required to utilize EVV:
